Pilot activity aimed at online testing was presented "Make your community SMARTER". The pilot activities were carried out in the spring of 2020 and involved 51 participants from Italy, Spain, Poland, Latvia and Croatia. The course covers the following topics: accessibility to all in public places, civil services, data mining, e-government, energy management, urban mobility, water management and waste management.
