During its first six months, the COUNT ME

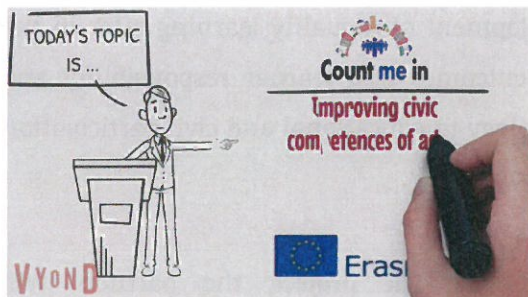
During the project, the partners will develop an online platform with open educational resources. It will include:
