The IO2 aims at extending of professional competences of adult educators working with low-educated youth and people with special needs and improving digital and civic competences of adult learners, which in its turn, increase their employability. It includes:

- Introductory e-course "Digital tools for Smart Development"
- Materials for Face-to-face training for adult educators
- Learning materials for the course targeting adult learners

The expected outcomes of this output are an increased level of digital skills and improved professional competences of adult educators working with adults from the disadvantaged groups.



The next project meeting, the 4<sup>o</sup> one, will be hosted by Apeirons in

covering all the areas addressed by the project: water, waste, energy management, e-governance, data mining, urban mobility, citizen services and access for all. The very next steps towards the completion of the e-course concern the development of the **learning materials**.
